

Ocean Energy Field Testimony Facility – OEA-J contracted with EMEC

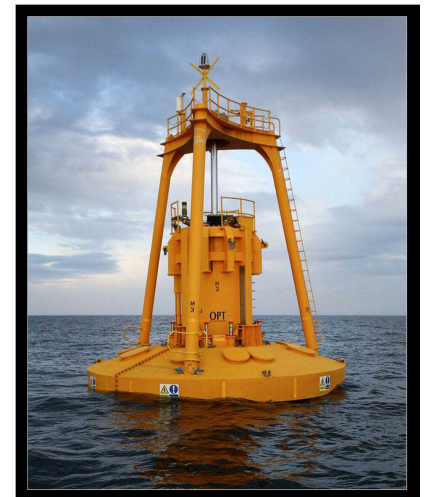
Ocean Energy Association-Japan, OEA-J contracted with Europe Marine Energy Center, EMEC subject to the field testimony facility in Japan for ocean energy utilization on March 9, 2012. EMEC is a private base organization sponsored by companies, plus Scotland and England governmental organization. They have the world biggest class power testimony facilities using wave and tidal current. By this contract, OEA-J became possible to use their know-how. The president OEA-J, Professor Ken Kinoshita, the University of Tokyo, insisted to accelerate its facilitation as soon as possible in Japan. Their target of installation is timed by end of 2013 fiscal year.



EMEC has and planned 15 testimony facilities in Scotland. Using their experience especially for the influence to the ocean lives, OEA-J intends to go ahead for the project, and to retrieve the delay of energy recovery from the marine resources from the world view of points.
